ITINERARY

DAY 01: KILIMANJARO (JRO) ARUSHA, TANZANIA

Arrival, Meet our Sky of Serengeti Safaris representative and Driver/ Guide. Pickup from Point of entry (Kilimanjaro International Airport). You will be driven in a 4WD Land Cruiser (MIN BUS) depending on group size, in either case the Safari Vehicles are specially designed for Safari with open roofs for game viewing and a guaranteed window seat for each passenger. It is possible to pick up and drop at Namanga, the Kenya/Tanzania Border, and arrangements can also be made to pick up at Airport of Nairobi, Kenya or arrange pick up in Nairobi by the Shuttle bus Nairobi – Arusha (Tanzania). Transfer to Arusha Town. You will be briefed by one of our representative on arrival at the Lodge. Extra Border Transfers shall be charged if arrivals in any other than Kilimanjaro Airport. Enquire current transfer charges. Visas will also be required depending on Nationalities-you can acquire Visas on arrival at the Bordercrossing.

DAY 02: ARUSHA / ARUSHA NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast at about 7:30am, walk around the Hotel gardens and depart for Arusha National Park with your picnic boxes for Lunch. You have a full day exploring the Ngurodoto Crater, the famous Momella Crater Lakes as well as clear views of Mount Meru (4500M above sea level), all Big Game including herds of buffaloes, Maasaï giraffes, Black and white colobus monkeys... will be viewed in their natural habitat with the exception of Wildlife. Flamingos are common at Momela Lake, though the bird life on these lakes vary seasonally. From October to April the lakes are populated by the water fowls from Europe, and the rest of the year the residents birds, grebes, pilchards, eagles and geese dominate the lakes. I even saw the Martial Eagle on an evening.

Dinner and overnight at Arusha Coffee Lodge. (L,D,B)

DAY 03-4: ARUSHA / TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, you will depart for Tarangire National Park for a game drive and picnic lunch box. Continue to reach the Tarangire Tree Top. You will have the option to enjoy night game drives and walking safaris, as well as to game drive in open vehicles (not included). Enjoy a bush breakfast in the shade of a majestic Baobab tree, or sundowners in the dry

riverbed. Tarangire National Park is the most southern of the accessible parks of Northern Tanzania. Named after River Tarangire, the park covers an area of 2,600 sq.km. Open grassy savannah, dotted with splendid specimens of baobab trees, but there are also areas of swamps in the south. The park is also spectacular in dry season when many of the migratory wildlife species come back to the permanent waters of the river until the onset of the rains when they migrate again for better pastures. This animal phenomenon takes place from June to September.

DAY 05: TARANGIRE /MANYARA NATIONAL PARK/NGORONGORO CRATER LODGE

This morning after breakfast, you will drive to Lake Manyara National Park. Activities here include a short walk around the Mto wa Mbu Village. Then lunch is followed by a game drive in the National Park famous for its herds of elephants & huge variety of birds. The Lake Manyara forest is the place to see Elephants, while lions hunt on the grassy shores of the lake. Drive to Ngorongoro Crater Lodge.

DAY 06: NGORONGORO / FULL DAY CRATER TOUR

Early morning breakfast, then drive to the Ngorongoro Crater for a half-day Crater Tour. Standing at 7,335 feet above sea level, Ngorongoro is the largest unbroken caldera in the world, its steep walls rising 2,000 feet from the floor. It is considered to be one of the wonders of the natural world and is a veritable heaven for wildlife. You will spend part of the day game viewing on the floor of the crater. Your afternoon is spent relaxing or walking around the lodge.

DAY 07: NGORONGORO / SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After your breakfast drive to Serengeti National Park with lunch box via Olduvai Gorge for a short visit and lecture, drive to Serengeti with game drive, enroute stop at Simba Kopjes for your picnic. After continue with game viewing on the way to your lodge. We do an after breakfast game viewing drive along the Banagi River Circuit, which loops into the plains south of the Seronera River, and which is good for possible Lion, Thomson gazelle, topi, ostrich and cheetah sightings. The Visitor Centre close to the Seronera Wildlife Lodge, is well worth a visit after the morning's game drive. This centre offers some interesting wildlife displays as well as a gift shop selling information leaflets and maps of the area. The centre also has a shop, as well as a picnic area and information trail up and around a nearby kopje. Relaxed picnic lunch at the centre below the giant acacia trees. We will follow the Kopjes Circuit, which goes anti-clockwise around the Maasaï Kopjes, which usually attract some lions and some cobras. Kopjes are weathered granite outcrops, scattered around the plains, most of which are miniature ecosystems, providing shade and drinking water in pools left in the rock after the rains.

DAY 08: SERENGETI CENTER / SERENGETI NORTHERN

Today we will leave after breakfast for a full day game viewing with picnic lunch box. We will make our way towards the Northern part of the Serengeti National Park. Far from the beaten tourist track, the Northern Serengeti offers the unique opportunity to explore the fantastic Serengeti undisturbed.

DAY 09: SERENGETI NORTHERN / FULL DAY GAME VIEWING

We will leave very early in the morning for a sunrise game drive when animals are very active hunting and grazing in the park with breakfast box and lunch box. Our main goal today will be following the Migration of about 2 millions wildebeests and zebras and a big number of predators hunting them as they migrate. We will spend full day in the northern

Serengeti; the stunning Mara River filled with hippos and crocodiles cuts through this part of the park and hosts of the greatest spectacles of Nature: the dramatic wildebeest's migration. It is in this part of the park where you can witness the world famous wildebeest's river crossing as seen on National Geographic or Ushuaia Channels on TV. In the evening return to the camp.

Dinner and overnight at Serengeti Migration Camp. (L,D,B)

DAY 10: SERENGETI / ARUSHA / KILIMANJARO (JRO) BACK HOME

Early morning breakfast, then after drive to Lobo Airstrip for your scheduled flight to Arusha, arrive and transfer to SHANGA for your hot lunch. After lunch we will have Town Tour around the Maasai market, where artisans from throughout Tanzania sell their work. This is a great place to purchase batik fabric, fine wood carvings, and even Tanzanite. Then at 18:00 pm drive to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your International Flights.


